Grape & the Grain

Ingredients:

- 50ml Lets Dance
- 25ml apple juice from concentrate
- 2 red grapes (seedless)
- 25ml water

Method:

Crush two red grapes into shaker, then pour in Let's Dance and the apple juice, shake and fine strain into an empty rocks glass.

Garnish with 3 red grapes on a cocktail stick.



Sparkles & Fire

Ingredients:

- 50ml Let's Dance whiskey
- 1 lemon
- Silver edible glitter
- Small bag of white sugar
- Water

Method:

Make a gomme syrup using the water and white sugar. Paint a sugar spiral onto the inside of a coupette glass. Sprinkle with silver edible glitter. Flame a lemon zest over the glass and pour in the whisky.
